



Important OSHA Changes to OSHA Outreach Training Program

New "Introduction to OSHA" Required Content *Emphasis on Workers Rights and Employer Responsibilities*

OSHA has developed a two-hour "Introduction to OSHA" module which places additional emphasis on worker's rights and employer responsibilities. OSHA will require that this curriculum is incorporated in its entirety into every 10-hour and 30 hour general industry, construction and maritime industry class.

The revised module focuses on the importance of workers' rights, employer responsibilities and how to file a complaint. It also includes helpful worker safety and health resources. The revised content covers the full range of worker's rights, including the right to a safe and healthful workplace, the right to know about hazardous chemicals, the right to review information about injuries and illnesses in their workplace, the right to receive training, the right to participate in an OSHA inspection, and the right to be free from retaliation for exercising their safety and health rights.
